
The Southern African Wildlife College (SAWC) is a world-renowned educational institution that specializes in conservation education, training, and skills development. Our guests experience a K9 demonstration (Anti-poaching dog unit) in the field, tour the field ranger training facility, and fly with a conservation pilot over the greater Kruger Area. Both evenings at SAWC include a safari, along with an intimate bush dinner on the second night. Additionally, we provide 2 optional excusrions; including 1.) visit a school in the nearby community to experience GCC's Future Ranger's Program, where local youth are being trained to become the next generation of wildlife guardians or 2.) a guided visit to the Moholoholo Wildlife Rehabilitation Center.




























The Timbavati Private Nature Reserve (TPNR) borders the Kruger National Park, with access to over 53 000 hectares of unspoilt natural wilderness. TPNR has one of the best protected rhino populations in the world, and relies heavily on field rangers to ensure their safety. GCC has been supporting the field rangers of the TPNR for the last 7 years with equipment, training and media exposure. We offer the experience to meet these wildlife guardians directly, and to spend a morning with them in the field, tracking rhinos and learning about a ranger's many responsibilities.






For more than 25 years, Elephants Alive has been working towards ensuring the survival of elephants and their habitats, and to promote the harmonious co-existence of elephants and people. Through GCC, we facilitate the option to fund an elephant collaring operation. These funds cover the cost of the elephant collar, veterinary time, helicopter and aerial support, and ground crew. Guests have the ability to assist the ground crew with various tasks, and get up, close and personal with Africa's largest mammal.






Kings Camp
